




## How to Insert Layer Annotations Above or Below the Layer in the GRANEDA Dynamic Gantt Chart

Open the dialog **Options Specify Bar Appearance**. Select the desired layer and click on **...** to open the **Edit layer** dialog. Click on the **Annotation** button to open the dialog **Edit layer annotation ""**. To create a field that is situated above or below the layer click on  or  while holding down the CTRL key. The contents of the text fields are taken either from **Data field** or **Constant text**.
